

LA GRANDE ODYSSÉE VVF

La Grande Odyssée VVF is one of the last playgrounds for these navigators of the white seas in search of the absolute. La Grande Odyssée VVF is also the story of a dream. The 20th edition of La Grande Odyssée VVF will take place from January 13th to 25th 2024. The public will also be able to follow the race through a digital monitoring system and daily appointments in the French media with more than 15 hours of TV broadcasting (TF1, TMC, France 3, BFM TV etc.), 13 hours of radio (France Bleu, France Inter etc.) and 250 articles in the written press.

La Grande Odyssée VVF

La Grande Odyssée VVF is, since its first edition in January 2005, the annual sled dog event in Europe. It is the most demanding stage race in a unique alpine setting. This year, an exceptional sporting line-up is expected with more than 55 mushers and their 600 dog-athletes coming from the great nations of European mushing (France, Switzerland, Spain, Germany, Italy, Poland, Netherlands and Norway). More than 50 000 spectators live each year a unique experience, in the heart of 20 resorts, towns and villages in the Alps, dressed up for the occasion, by attending La Grande Odyssée VVF.

ANNABEL KAM

President

Has been responsible for communication and press relations since 2011. Following the death of her father Henry Kam (founder of the event) in November 2017, she organizes and directs La Grande Odyssée VVF.

He is in charge of «making real during the race» everything that has been imagined and organized during the period of preparation.

Official judge of the French Federation of Sleds Sports. She is in charge of the application of the rules during the races.

Chief Veterinary Officer

Doctor of Veterinary Medicine, she manages the team of vets in charge of the health of the «dog-athletes» during throughout the race.



Sports Director

Specialist and passionate about mushing, the Sporting Director is responsible for the sporting aspect of La Grande Odyssée VVF.



THE KEY NOTIONS OF THE RULES

The general functioning

On La Grande Odyssée VVF, each dog is identified by a microchip injected under the skin and identified by one of the 10 veterinarians present throughout the race.

The musher has his "pool" for the whole race. La Grande Odyssée VVF. For each stage, a maximum number of dogs is authorized at the start and a minimum number a minimum number of dogs at the finish may be indicated by the trace direction according to the difficulties of the track.

The musher has the possibility to «drop» (leave) his tired dogs at certain check points and he has the the obligation to transport in his sled a tired or injured dog in his sled if he is not on a place where the «drop» is allowed.

A dropped dog or a dog in a sled must be examined as soon as possible by an official veterinarian.

The health of the dogs is a constant concern at all times. A veterinarian has the power to sanction, or even exclude, a musher who would not have care of his dogs.

Anti-doping policy

Anti-doping tests will be carried out on the dogs by the authorized organizations. The regulations

describes precisely the list of authorized products and those that are not.

Controls can also be carried out on the mushers by random urine sampling.

Mandatory equipment

The musher must have in his sled or on him, a certain number of mandatory equipment for his safety, even his survival and that of his dogs (avalanche victim detector, GPS, survival blankets). This equipment is checked before the departure of each stage, on all the teams.

Winnings and prizes

La Grande Odyssée VVF offers 25 750 € in prize money as well as special prizes, see opposite.

PODIUMS, JERSEYS AND SPECIAL PRIZES

Stage podiums

According to the ranking of the stage, the first 3 mushers per category climb on the podium and are rewarded by the station of the day and by the partner.

The Crédit Mutuel « Leader » Jersey

The Crédit Mutuel « Leader » jersey is awarded by category, to the first of the overall.



The Crédit Mutuel « Best Nordic » jersey

The Crédit Mutuel « Best Nordic » jersey is awarded to the best purebred Nordic (Siberian Husky) team in each category (Siberian husky) with the best overall ranking best classified in the general classification.



The Royal Canin Dog Care Award

The Royal Canin « Dog Care » Jersey is awarded to the to the musher whose behaviour towards his dogs the most animal-friendly health, on the stage, with outstanding actions.



The Royal Canin Best Dog Care Award

The Royal Canin « Best Dog Care » jersey is awarded to the team that has demonstrated the most application, control and efficiency in the care of the dogs of the the team at the end of the race. Awarded by the team of veterinarians.



The final podium and special awards

The Henry Kam Prize

This prize is awarded to the winner of all categories of the Val Cenis stage (stage over 2 days including a night in a bivouac), in tribute to the founder of the race.



The Golden Harness Award

Awarded by category to the most impressive dog of the winning team, chosen by the musher.



Rookie of the Year Award

Awarded by category to the highest ranked musher among those who have completed the race and are participating the race for the first time, or who have never finished the race, completed the race.



The Red Lantern Award

Awarded by category to the last musher in the among those who took part and finished all stages of the and completed all stages of the race in their entirety. This is a tradition in the mushing world that goes back to the dates back to the gold rush. At that time, as long as a musher was on the trail, the lantern remained lit, it was only turned it off when he returned.



The Fair Play Award with Alpes Ishere



Awarded to the musher of La Grande Odyssée VVF who demonstrated the most fair play and sportsmanship towards towards the other competitors. This prize is awarded by the mushers.



The Combativity Award with Suzuki

The Combativeness Award is given to the competitor who has performed an "outstanding" action over the course of the race or at a specific moment of the race that shows energy, stamina and the will to never give up in order to achieve to achieve his or her goal.

During the Chapelle d'Abondance stage of La Grande Odyssé VVF, on Monday January 15th, the children of the Pays d'Evian Vallée d'Abondance become mushers competitors. The Odyssée des Enfants is a race entirely dedicated to children.


It is the result of a partnership with the Territory of Evian - Valley of Abondance. Thus, for one day, the children will evolve in the same conditions as the mushers participating in the official stage of the Chapelle d'Abondance: same infrastructures, same sites of departure and arrival, announcer and many spectators.

Twenty young mushers, from the college Pays de Gavot of the Valley of Abondance, previously selected and trained by professional mushers, will participate in the race « l'Odyssée des Enfants » with teams of 3 or 4 dogs over 4 km, on the track that will be used a few hours later by the a few hours later by the world's elite mushers in La Grande Odyssée VVF.



The Odyssey of Hopes is a race for mushers from 12 to 17 years old attached to the hope pole of the FFST (Fédération Française des Sports de Traineau).

The start will be mass start on Saturday January 20 at Bessans at 13 h. The young mushers will travel 11km through the magnificent mountain landscapes. A pool of 4 to 6 dogs is authorized for the race (each musher is independent in terms of equipment and dog).


Veterinarians Team

The Veterinarians Team Sled dog races, whether they are amateur or professional, speed or long distance, non-stop with check-points or by stages, now all include a team of veterinarians.

On a race like La Grande Odyssée VVF, the « Team Vets « is composed of 11 experienced vets, as well as a student vet, permanent and 8 in support for the pre-race controls. All volunteers, passionate about canine medicine and its practice in sports, these specialists ensure the respect of the physical integrity of these athletes, and guarantee their well-being. The Team Vétérinaires is equipped with state-of-the-art technology for its mission. La Grande Odyssée VVF's Veterinarians Team is directed by Dr Sandrine Pezard-Van Parijs.

Dr. Pezard-Van Parijs is an associate practitioner of the Association of Veterinarians of the Ark in the Orne and Sarthe regions. Graduated in 2005 from the University of Liege, she first started a general practice before specializing in osteopathy (DIE of Veterinary Osteopathy in 2012).





The missions of the Team of Veterinarians

The Team of Veterinarians ensures the well-being and good health of the dogs competing during the entire race.

In addition to the regulatory health checks before the race, the veterinarians validate, after a complete and specific clinical examination, the participation of each dog presented at the start of the race. Thus, before each stage, the veterinarians give the approval or not to take the start (the pre-race «vetcheck»).

They also monitor the health of the dogs during the races, intervene in case of emergency and provide recommendations and possible care after each stage. The main problems encountered are infections related to high-level sport, including osteoarticular trauma (e.g. sprains, tendonitis, digestive disorders, pad injuries, etc.).

They are then «on the job» 24 hours a day for the duration of the race, each team being monitored daily on several occasions (before and after each stage, but also via veterinary checks on the track and during the night bivouac at altitude). It is also possible, according to the rules of La Grande Odyssée VVF, to temporarily exclude a dog from a team in order to get it back into shape, in the respect of its well-being, its health and the regulations.


Each year the French Agency for the Fight against Doping comes to take unannounced samples from the canine athletes and thus attest to the ethics of the competitors and the race. of the competitors and the race.

ANIMAL HEALTH

The animal health doctrine

In order to meet the objective of animal health and the respect of sporting rules inherent to all major competitions, La Grande Odyssée VVF has enriched, since 2014, the rules of the race with the animal health doctrine.

This document describes the general doctrine followed by the Vet Team. It includes the missions and determines with precision the role of the team's veterinarians, and the general ethics regarding animal health. It is signed and accepted by all mushers participating in one of the events organized within the framework of La Grande Odyssée VVF.





Scientific & therapeutic advances at the service of animal welfare

Technology in the service of health

For several years now, the Team Vétérinaires has been using very high level technical equipment: a real field hospital.

La Grande Odyssée VVF is the only race in the world to benefit from this type of equipment in the field. The teams participating in the race are at such a high level of performance that it becomes essential to have the most precise and quickest medicine and diagnosis possible.

Thanks to the scil laboratory (official supplier), it is possible to carry out digital X-rays, ultrasounds and blood tests in the middle of the mountains and in extreme conditions. This high-tech equipment has demonstrated the reliability and precision of the machines in extreme conditions up to 2,500 m altitude and at 15° C below zero.

This year again, the Veterinarians Team is equipped with a real state-of-the-art equipment in the field: digital radiography by autonomous plane sensor, hematology, biochemistry, ultrasound.

Prevention and treatment actions

The dogs of La Grande Odyssée VVF, just like top athletes, make intense efforts which induce important pressures on their joints. This high stress on the joints can precipitate the onset of a chronic disease that affects about 20% of dogs: arthrosis.

Osteoarthritis in dogs is very similar to that in humans. It can occur in one or more joints and will affect all the components (bone, cartilage, synovial fluid).

This is why it is important to protect them to delay the onset of osteoarthritis or to treat them when it is already present. In order to support the joint metabolism of sporting dogs and dogs with osteoarthritis, veterinarians recommend a multimodal approach, depending on the progress of the pathology:

- Good hygiene for the animal: limit weight gain, maintain proper muscle training and respect recovery phases
- Physiotherapy with massages and hot or cold therapies. In the recovery phase and in cases of marked inflammation, veterinarians can use a recent technology that helps limit inflammation: laser.
- Chondroprotectors (complementary foods) such as Flexadin Advanced
- Anti-inflammatories and painkillers, during obvious pain crises, which will be prescribed by a veterinarian.

Dogs, like humans, are not helpless in the face of this complex disease. There are therefore complementary solutions that can greatly limit the consequences of osteoarthritis.





Scientific approach

Presentation of the project

Since its creation, La Grande Odyssée VVF has always attached great importance to animal health.

In parallel to the race, a working group composed of veterinarians and students has been created to carry out a scientific reflection on the sled dog and its health and well-being.

The objectives of this group are to carry out on La Grande Odyssée VVF, a scientific analysis of the data collected on the dogs in order to ensure a more effective veterinary follow-up of these high level canine athletes, to improve the knowledge around the sled dog to make evolve the practice in this field and finally to restore these results to the mushers.

The students are recruited and directed by Dr Sandrine Van Parijs Pezard, chief veterinarian of La Grande Odyssée VVF. They will carry out their thesis and will contribute to this scientific project thanks to the data collected on the race and to the supervision of several personalities of the veterinary world

The start of the opening ceremony (Megève) will be given on Saturday, January 13, 2024 during an afternoon full of entertainment that will be closed by fireworks and an opening ceremony.

The start of the 20th edition will be given in Megève Côte 2000 on Sunday January 14th 2024 in front of a very large audience. The finish is scheduled for Thursday, January 25, 2024 in Villard-de-Lans, in the Vercors. This 19th edition will end with a great ceremony closing ceremony.

Bivouac - Polar Base of La Grande Odyssée VVF

Stage 7 of La Grande Odyssée VVF is legendary for its traditional overnight bivouac, where mushers and dogs sleep under the stars at over 2,000 m altitude.

On Saturday night, a camp is set up at the Base Polaire in Val Cenis. Overlooked by the famous Mont Cenis lake, the Base Polaire is a cult race venue.

Located in the Haute Murienne Vanoise region between France and Italy, it offers a unique experience at very high altitude.

A challenge of more than 50 km for the teams over 2 days.

A large number of access points are planned along the itinerary so that spectators can get as close as possible to the passage of the teams on foot, snowshoes, crosscountry skis, downhill skis and even cross-country skis, possibly accompanied by professionals from the resorts.

Initiation to dog sledding, igloo building, trapper workshops are offered to vacationers and school children in the region. schools in the region.

The press releases


Press releases are sent throughout the year.
